Transit Training Consortium Delivers over 6000 Hours of Training

Long Beach, CA - The Southern California Transit Training Consortium (SCR TTC) announced it has delivered over 6000 training hours to 14 Transit agencies located in Southern California.

Transit agencies throughout Southern California and the associated Community Colleges have joined together to provide training for transit agencies who are members of the consortium. The training is provided to maintenance technicians and supervisors who are responsible for public transit operations in the metropolitan Los Angeles area. This training is funded by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and it is part of the Professional Capacity Building Program administered by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

The training provided addresses the use and maintenance of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) currently being implemented by several of the transit agencies.

Typical training courses include the following:

- ISE Safety Training for Hybrid Propulsion Systems
- Brakes for Transit
- Electrical Systems Maintenance courses related to the maintenance and operation of ITS

The SCR TTC is a coalition of over 30 transit operators, community colleges and other educational institutions in Southern California, joined together to develop industry driven, competency based curriculum that meets present and future technological needs of public transit systems. The SCR TTC has been designated as a 501 (c)(3) organization, as well as a California Non-Profit Corporation.
