Proterra's initial product, a 35' all-electric transit bus, has been designed from the ground up to enable a world's first ever solution for transit agencies to replace convention diesel buses on a one-for-one basis with all-electric buses operating 24/7. The vehicle achieves between 18 and 29 miles per gallon diesel fuel equivalent fully loaded with 68 passengers - 500% better than a comparable diesel bus.
